

Thank you for agreeing to review the enclosed book for *Reformation and Renaissance Review*.

Reviews should normally be c1000 words in length. Reviewers may make the case for a longer review where they feel this is warranted (eg. in the case of a review article or the review of more than one book).

Completed reviews should be headed with publication details in the following format:

From Judaism to Calvinism: The Life and Writings of Immanuel Tremellius (c.1510-1580), by Kenneth Austin. St Andrews Studies in Reformation History. Aldershot: Ashgate Publishing, 2007. 233pp., hb., £55.00, ISBN 9780754652335.

Details of pricing and pagination can usually be obtained from the book itself or from a publisher's or bookseller's website (e.g. www.amazon.co.uk).

At the end of the review, please append your name, the name of your institution (unless you are currently free-lance), and your email address.

Once you have completed the review, you should submit it through the journal website at: <http://www.equinoxjournals.com/ojs/index.php/RRR/about/submissions>

There you should either register as a 'new author' or, if you have previously registered, 'log on'. Once registered/logged on, click 'new submission' and follow the instructions. The website will ask you, *inter alia*, for a Library of Congress classification of your review. I find that the easiest way to find this is to search for the book on the Library of Congress catalogue: <http://catalog.loc.gov/> and to enter the 'call number' for the appropriate record.

It is important that you submit your review through the journal website. This allows you to track where your review is in the editorial process, and it ensures that copies of the review are stored in a location accessible to all of the journal editors.
